## **Tools + Resources**

#### **Suggested Tools**

- Marking Paint and Tape Measure
- Safety Gear: Gloves, heavy work boots, tall socks, pants, long sleeve shirts, dust masks, protective eye wear, ear plugs, and hard hats (if using heavy machinery)
- Garden Tools: Spades, shovels, rakes, trash bags, and wheelbarrows
- Truck, to pick-up trees and mulch
- · Ball Cart, for moving heavy trees

- · Garden Hose with potential extension hose
- Sprinkler
- Rain Barrel in addition to other water source

• Mulch or Wood Chips, 1 cubic yard

### Planting

- · Redbud, 1 pot or balled and burlapped
- Sugar Maple, 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- Black Cherry, 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- Horse Chestnut, 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- Hawthorn, 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- Balsam Fir, 2 pots or balled and burlapped

## **Remaining Lot (Optional)**

#### Groundcover

- Low-Maintenance Fescue Mix, 15 pounds of seed
- Germination Blanket, 4 rolls (8 by 112.5 feet)
