Suggested Tools

- Safety Gear: Gloves, heavy work boots, tall socks, pants, long sleeve shirts, dust masks, protective eye wear, ear plugs, and hard hats (if using heavy machinery)
- Garden Tools: Spades, shovels, rakes, trash bags, and wheelbarrows
- · Tiller, 6 inch depth

- · Sprinkler
- Rain Barrel in addition to other water source

- Bonemeal, 120 pounds or 5 bags of 24 pounds of Bone Meal Plant Food
- · Organic Material, 27 cubic yards (optional)
- · Red Wiggler Worms, 126,000 worms
- · Worm Casting, 214 pounds
- **Duff**, 27 cubic yards (60 bales of straw or shredded cardboard)

Groundcover

- Low-Maintenance Fescue Mix, 15 pounds of seed
- **Germination Blanket**, 4 rolls (8 by 112.5 feet)

Compost Bed (Optional)

Materials

- Cinder Blocks or Bricks, to create a 6 by 4 by 2 foot raised bed
- · Chicken Wire, 26 to 30 square feet
- **Duff**, 0.2 cubic yards (straw or shredded cardboard)
- · Red Wiggler Worms, 12,000 worms
- Worm Casting, 2 pounds
